


Communities Served

Process and Methods Used

- Community Survey
 - Conducted by HealthStream, Inc.
 - Over 500 telephone surveys completed
- Personal Interviews
 - Conducted with key community and health leaders who were unable to attend focus group meetings



Process and Methods Used (cont.)

- Population Estimates and Demographics
 - U.S. Census Bureau data
- Focus Groups
 - Input received from over 20 individuals representing organizations from Watertown and surrounding communities
